After being stationed at Padgate for several months, I thought it would be a good idea if I volunteered for an overseas posting to see more of the world at the Government's expense. After all, I I had to do two years' service and as I had volunteered to do three years I thought I would take advantage of my situation and volunteer for services in the Far East. When I was offered a posting to Singapore and Malaya I was quite excited at the prospect, being only 18 years of age. People had not yet started to go to the Mediterranean so the Far East was something special.

I was posted to RAF Insworth in Gloucester for kitting out in my KD (Khaki Drill). From there I went to London to Blackbush Airport for a flight by Hermes to Singapore. With an overnight stop in London before the flight I took the opportunity to sight see and was fortunate to be shown round London by a Londoner who was booked on the same flight as myself. He showed me Buckingham Palace, Big Ben, The Houses of Parliament, No 10 Downing Street, etc. noit having been to London before, this was the start of my overseas education. The next day, we flew to Rome for refuelling, crossing the Alps which was quite bumpy. Also seeing ladies working tin the gents toilet was quite an eye-opener!

We then flew to RAF Nicosia in Cyprus for a night stop. Here we found more RAF personnel stranded due to the EOKA terrorists targeting their plane and putting it out of action. So we were glad to leave Cyprus. We then flew to Bahrein to another RAF base for refuelling , again it was a lot warmer here and all the RAF Personnel worked stripped to the waist. We then flew to Karachi for a next overnight stop in a hotel where we were able to get our laundry done and had it back next morning for our journey.

Next was New Delhi for refuelling and it was really hot, as it happened to be midday when we were there. after refuelling, we proceeded to Calcutta for an overnight stop at a very nice hotel. We had to leave very early in the morning for our take-off and we found that that was when they collected the bodies of those who had died during the night! Again, more education...

This time we flew to Bangkok, a very clean airport and it was very nice to see the young ladies in their cheongsams walking around the airport, especially for us young men. We refuelled then flew at last to Singapore.

With all of the stops for refuelling and overnights, it had been quite an interesting time taking the best part of a week on the journey to Singapore. We arrived at RAF Changi to stay at a transport block while we got fitted out with our KD Gear ready for our posting to our permanent stations which turned out to be RAF Tengall, my home for the next two years.
