#### 5 Treasurer's Report

The Secretary read out the Treasurers report.

Greetings from sunny South West France, I hope you have a delicious lunch and a brief AGM. My apologies for being unable to attend the AGM – blame Brexit!

Balance £2292.23 as of 15th March 2019 an increase of £194.72 v 31st March 2018

51 members paid 2018-19 subscriptions to the end of the accounts

3 members paid 2019-20 subscriptions to the end of the accounts. However, one member kindly paid a subscription of £100 in error. The £90 refund will appear in the accounts next year.

The largest expenditure was the 50th Anniversary Celebration which at the time resulted in a net loss of £559 This was offset by £847 worth of assets (car badges, bar clips, lapel badges etc) some of which have now been sold and included in the current balance.

Income and payments referred to as 'Meal BH' were due to 6 members being unable to attend the March Noggin at Browsholme Hall. As this was an exclusive event, they opened just for us, we were charged for the 6 meals and the members involved will recompense the centre. To the end of the accounts only 2 meal payments had been cleared. The other 4 payments will appear in the accounts next year.
