This family-owned eatery, being part of the San Marco group, did serve a varied fare with both modern and traditional Italian dishes. It hath expanded much since our last visit over ten years ago, now seating more than three hundred souls.

Our company was seated together and served with great efficiency by amiable staff. Authentic Italian food and drink were enjoyed by all.

Conversations didst range from future holiday plans to notions for forthcoming gatherings as distinguished members circulated around the tables. The chariots outside attracted much admiration, with discourse continuing under the sunlit heavens in the car park.

A Drop Head Coupé Project By Roger Benton (not Al)

This is project started by David Roberts over 30 years ago and was reported on in the June 2023 issue of the Norcemoa newsletter. The objective of this project is to produce a period correct +8 Drop Head Coupé based on the last DHC produced by the Morgan factory, this factory car was built on a +8 chassis with Rover V8 and Borg Warner automatic gearbox. This final DHC was built for Peter Morgan's wife Jane Morgan.







The pictures above show Jane Morgan with the DHC and lower right the car as it is today in the Morgan factory museum.

My involvement in this project started on the 17th January 2024 (at 15:35 to be precise) with a text from David asking if I would like to be part of this project. My response was yes but with a caveat - would I be able to fit in the DHC and do so comfortably?

David was very accommodating by being willing to adjust the seat position (allowing to slide further back than normal) and pedal positions and even the steering wheel



position. The picture on the right shows myself sitting in the DHC though you might need to use your imagination a little but from this I was very encouraged that this

project would work for me. I also liked David's philosophy of wanting to produce a car that would look amazing and be suitable for what the original was designed for and that is long distant comfortable cruising in a stylish eloquent car.

David also introduced me to Dixon Smith, who was the subject of an article in the October 2023 issue of Miscellany, who also owns a DHC and it was a chance to have a close look at an original DHC. I did try to sit in Dixon's car but Dixon is not tall and I'm 6'2", I couldn't even get a leg in the car!

The Morgan factory have been exceptionally helpful in allowing us to crawl all over Jane Morgan's in the Morgan Museum. I was particularly encouraged when I sat in the car finding the driving position to be exceptionally comfortable, see the picture on the right.

Over this past year progress on the car has been a little slower than desired but has been steady. I am particularly pleased with the Ash frame made for us



by Nigel Hall. New valances and bulk head have been fabricated in steel and the bulk head as been powder coated. Recently we fitted the steering box, column and steering wheel and for the first time we could sit in and steer the car!

One big decision was to where to have the car panelled, we visited 'Pristine Panel Work Ltd' owned by Lee Irish, his work shop was very impressive so we are hoping that at the end of April we will be delivering the car to Lee Irish for panelling. This will take about 2 months to complete and will transform the look of the car.



Those attending the post-AGM afternoon tea event will be able to see the project's progress 'in the flesh' and even get a chance to sit in, what it is hoped will become when finished sometime next year, a rather special Morgan motor car.
