Tip of the Month

Many Morgans proudly display badges fitted to the badge bar attached to the chrome radiator grill. However, the majority are mounted such that the badges interrupt significantly, the air-flow through the cowl and to the radiator.

The cooling on Morgans is generally marginal to say the least and much of this is caused by the area of high pressure within the engine bay that discourages the air from flowing through the radiator. In fact the air will flow anywhere, over the wings and bonnet and under the car rather than through the radiator.

Any easy way of helping matters is to lower the height of the badges; this is easily done by removing the badge bar, dismounting the badges, rotating the badge bar 180 degrees and reassembling the badges and bar to the car.

In effect, you will have lowered the badges by some two to three inches thereby assisting the airflow through your radiator and helping your engine's cooling system, all for no cost other than half an hour of your time and some soap and water to wash your hands.
